 - Can collect when visiting surgery for other purposes
 - If any queries can discuss with dispensary staff, GPs or practice nurses
 - Accessibility 8am-6.30pm Monday – Friday & Saturday mornings
 - Can place orders for repeat medication by email or using voice mail at any time of day or night
 - Ease of car parking
 - Surgery has other distribution arrangements for those who are house-bound or find it difficult to visit the surgery
 - Do not have to make two journeys, if seeing doctor or nurse, prescription is dispensed immediately in same building
 - To have the choice of being able to collect your medication from your surgery
